ABA has helped people in need of behavioral and learning interventions in many areas, but is most well-known for its application in the field of autism treatment, being the only treatment scientifically proven to bring about significant, lasting improvement for individuals with autism. The Skills[®] for Autism tool itself has 10 published research studies on the effectiveness, efficiency and validity of the tool and its content.
